

## A Parent's Guide to Navigating SISD's Curriculum and Instruction Resources Online



The Sealy ISD Curriculum and Instruction Department, with the support and assistance of the Sealy ISD teachers, is continuously working to increase the learning resources and information available on the Sealy ISD Curriculum and Instruction website for parents, students, and teachers. It is important for parents to know what students are learning so that they can support the learning process at home.

Below is a guide to assist viewers with navigating the resources that are available online.

- 1) To access the SISD Curriculum and Instruction website, go to <a href="www.sealyisd.com">www.sealyisd.com</a>.
  - On the left-hand side, select Departments then Curriculum and Instruction.
- 2) From this point, you will select the subject area of interest.
  - The "C&I Home" site has general information, announcements, and reports. This page also has
    a folder on the right-hand side labeled "Tools & Resources for Parents". Please look here for
    tools and resources that may assist in supporting students in the learning process at home.
    There are suggested activities and tools with information on relevant content at various grade
    levels.
  - There is also a folder on the C&I Home page that provides information on the SISD Grading Guidelines, Grading Cycles and Grade Reporting Dates, and UIL Eligibility Guidelines.
- 3) Select your area of interest:
  - Electives & Fine Arts
  - English Language Arts and Reading
  - Mathematics
  - Science
  - Social Studies

Once you have selected a subject area, a page will appear with grade level folders. Select the grade level of your choice.

- In each grade level folder you will find:
  - The Year-at-a-Glance which is a brief overview of the knowledge and skills that will be covered in each grading cycle.
  - The Unit Bundles/Pacing Guides which gives additional details on content, skills and vocabulary that will be covered and duration of time dedicated to each unit. If you have specific questions about the learning activities taking place on a daily basis in your student's classroom(s), please contact your child's teacher.
